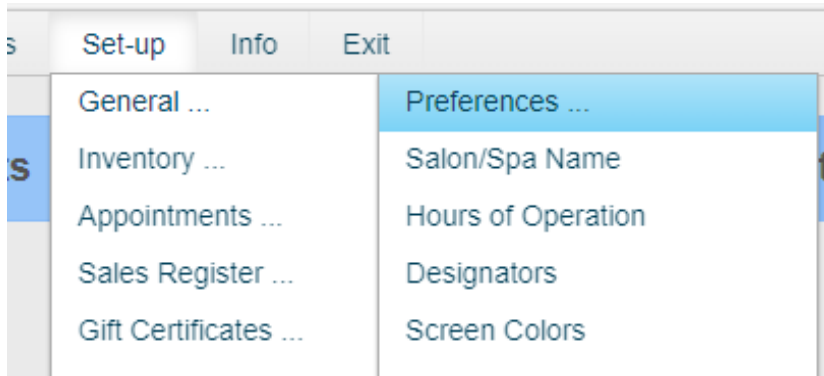


Points Earnings for Retail

Please note that each points-earning class runs simultaneously with any others you may create. For this reason, you must not create conflicting classes. Each class should focus on its own unique earnings for gift certificates, packages, series, services, retail, or referrals.

1. From the main screen select Setup/General/Preferences.



2. Select and Activate 'Enable "Points" Program'



3. You may choose to activate “Do NOT Allow Partial Point Redemptions as well. However, that is not required. Briefly, this selection means that if the customer has not earned enough “points” to get the product or service for “free” then they may not use their points at all. If however, you DO allow Partial Point Redemptions, your customers may use their points to get “discounts” rather than “free.”

4. Upon activating “Enable Points Program” the following screen appears

5. To Create a new points earnings “class” click “New” then type in the name of your class. (Your customers will not see these class names, these are for your information and can be named anything at all.)

6. After entering the name of the new earnings class (we used the name “Retail” for the new class) you will then select which items this particular class will affect. You do this by placing a check mark in the box next to the items you wish to be affected by this class in the “Other” box. In this lesson we will select “All Retail”

7. To the right of the “Other” box you will see a list of the Categories of products you offer. Place a check next to the category or categories you would like to work with and then press “load” and the products from that category or categories will appear. You will place a check mark in the box to the left of the service name that you would like this earnings class to apply to.

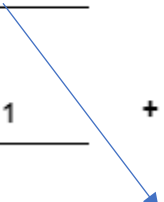

8. Once you have selected the services or products you wish to include in this points program, you will then move to the right center of the screen and use the following:

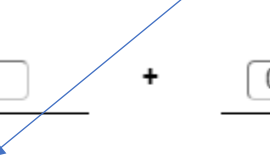


Here you will enter the number of points a single spent dollar will earn the customer on the services or products you have selected. Then, you may enter additional points earned as well.

The number after the plus “+” sign will be additional points earned that don’t require dollars spent. For example, if this was for a referral, you could have \$1 = 0 and “+” = 50. This would give the customer 50 points for a referral that they, obviously, did not spend any money on.

9. Below the “Earnings” detail we have the “Redemptions” detail. In this box you will place how many points will equal “=” a dollar. For example, you may have \$1 = 1 point but 20 points = \$1. This means the customer spending \$20 would earn 20 points, and could redeem those 20 points for a single dollar’s worth of value in your business.
